

Danger Level 1 - Low



Tendency: Increasing avalanche danger on Friday 01 04 2022

Some snow will fall on Thursday. The backcountry touring conditions are favourable.

High altitudes and the high Alpine regions: Hardly any increase in avalanche danger as a consequence of the snowfall.

In some localities increase in danger of wet snow slides as a consequence of the rain, in particular on steep shady slopes at intermediate altitudes.

Snowpack

In some regions up to 10 cm of snow will fall on Thursday above approximately 2000 m. The mostly small wind slabs are bonding well with the old snowpack. Less snow than usual is lying.


Tendency

Over a wide area 10 to 20 cm of snow, and even more in some localities, will fall on Friday. The fresh snow and the mostly small wind slabs are lying on the favourable surface of an old snowpack.





Danger Level 1 - Low



Tendency: Increasing avalanche danger on Friday 01 04 2022

Some snow will fall on Thursday. The backcountry touring conditions are favourable.

High Alpine regions: In some localities increase in avalanche danger as a consequence of the snowfall.

Snowpack

Over a wide area 5 to 15 cm of snow will fall on Thursday above approximately 2000 m. The mostly small wind slabs are bonding well with the old snowpack. Less snow than usual is lying.

Tendency

Over a wide area 10 to 30 cm of snow, and even more in some localities, will fall on Friday. Gradual increase in danger of dry avalanches as a consequence of new snow and wind.
